

Lead poisoning can cause lifelong health problems

Here are a few things you can do as a parent/guardian:

Talk with your child's school

Ask the teachers to monitor your child's learning and behavior

Talk with your child's doctor

If your child has a venous blood lead level over $5 \mu g/dL$, your child needs extra developmental and behavioral screening

Be your child's advocate

- Children birth to age 3 years can get services through Early Intervention
- Children 3 to 5 years and over 5 years can get services through the school district. Your child can benefit by getting services early.
