#### **CERVICAL CANCER SCREENINGS FOR WOMEN <40**

At this time, CSP-FLR is not able to enroll any woman under the age of 40 for a cervical cancer screening. In the meantime, we are directing women under 40 in need of cervical cancer screenings to other agencies that can help pay for those services.

#### PATIENTS OVERDUE FOR SCREENINGS

CSP-FLR is contacting all patients who are overdue for In NYS, nearly 16,000 women will their cancer screenings and helping them to schedule appointments. **Our Town Rocks** (OTR) is located in the town of Dundee in Yates County, and is based on the principles of Asset Based Community Development (ABCD). OTR's mission is to assist and celebrate local residents in and around Dundee towards creating "community". Currently, OTR is still serving Yates County residents, but has had to reschedule or cancel some programs in response to COVID-19. OTR has continued to share needed information and more importantly, has used social media to celebrate the faces and deeds of the community through pictures and videos.

Their office remains open and offers computer/Wi-Fi service for those who need electronic communications and have no internet service or home computer. Volunteers at OTR are helping at food pantries, and a free "Pick and Choose" table is set up every day outside their office at 12 Main Street in Dundee, as weather

### WHAT DOES THE CSP OFFER?\*

- Clinical breast exams and screening mammograms for average risk uninsured women 40 and older.
- Pap and pelvic exams for average risk uninsured women 40 and older.
- At-home kits to screen for colorectal cancer for average risk uninsured men and women age 50 and older.

\*Patients at high risk due to symptoms or a personal or family history of cancer may be eligible for testing at a younger age.
