Rochester's Double Helix Curriculum begins its 26th year in 2024. This integrated curriculum includes the Primary Care Clinical Clerkship that begins in March of the first year of medical school and includes much of the ambulatory medicine taught in Family Medicine, Medicine, and Pediatrics in the first two years of medical school. Most medical schools do not begin their clerkships until the latter part of the second year or the beginning of the third year of medical school.

RESEARCH FUNDING

Total funding this last fiscal year for faculty in the School of Medicine and Dentistry was about \$300 million. This places us in the top quartile of medical schools nationally, despite the fact that URMC is among the smallest of this elite group of schools. Our School of Nursing ranks in the top third in NIH funding among our nation's nursing schools.
