- 25 Aug – Hurricane Harvey makes landfall
- 28 Aug – TR boat operations
- 29 Aug – First operational period
- 01 Dec – Fully demobilized
- 02 Apr – Pilot rebuilding program initiated

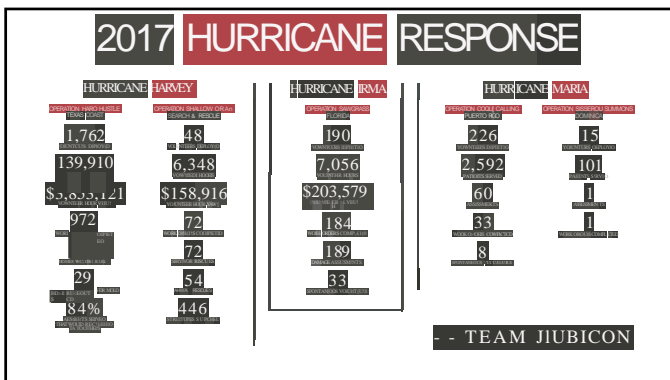

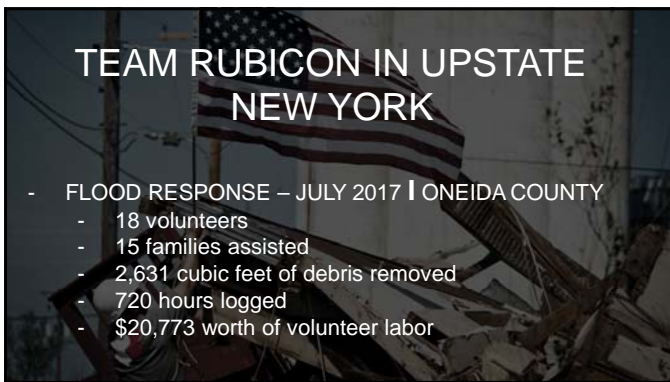

- Over 2,200 Greyshirts deployed
- Over 450 Greshirts remotely engaged in support of Operations
- Over 1,100 hurricane affected homes serviced
- Over \$5.5 million in value of volunteer work hours
- Over 1,000 patients seen in Puerto Rico and other islands
- Over 90 boat rescues performed
- Over 1.3 million cubic square feet of debris removed
