REQUIRED Equipment/Supplies:

- 9 eFINDS Training/Demo barcodes per workstation
- NYSDOH issued eFINDS Scanner
- Laptop with Wi-Fi capability if indicated (only if training is NOT in a computer lab)

9 eFINDS Demo Barcodes (per work station) will be utilized during the training session. Please print a PDF copy of your Demo/Training Barcode Assignment Scannable Log and bring to the training. Only individuals with an eFINDS Reporting Administrator role can access the Scannable Log. Click here for instructions on downloading the PDF Barcode Assignment Scannable Log.

NOTE: eFINDS barcodes are restricted to one-time-use. If you've utilized all demo barcodes in a previous exercise or training you must request additional barcodes be added to your training/demo cache.

Requests for additional Barcodes: Facilities should send an e-mail to efinds@health.ny.gov and copy the appropriate NYSDOH RO Representative. The facility should provide a 1 week notice if possible. Refer to NYSDOH Non-emergency eFINDS Request Process for more details.

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Pre-requisites:

- Have a current and active Health Commerce System (HCS) account. If you have a HCS account it must be active (you have accessed Commerce within the past six months).
- Assigned an eFINDS role in the Communications Directory as an eFINDS Reporting Administrator
