Mr Turner is the Vice President, Surgical Services at the Erie County Medical Center, a position that he has held since February 2001. He provides administrative and clinical oversight of the Surgical and Cardiac service lines, focusing on coordination of peri-operative patient care and non-invasive procedural interventions. His Service Lines conducts 20,000 procedures annually, he has been involved in the development of three minimally invasive OR suites, a new Electrophysiology lab, Endoscopy GI suite, and Ambulatory Surgery /Recovery Room expansion, as well as the development of a 16 million dollar Ambulatory Surgical Center which just opened in January 2014. In his position he serves as one of the Administrator's on Call for the Trauma Center.

Mr. Turner has an AAS in Surgical Technology from Niagara Community College; an AAS in Nursing from Erie Community College and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Daemen College. In 2011, he completed the Harvard Business School Healthcare Delivery Program for Senior Healthcare Executives.
