Overview:

The 2021 Healthcare Coalition Emergency Management Recorded Webinar Series: Trauma **Management for Rural EMS And Community** Hospitals (Trauma REACH 2021) is designed to better prepare hospital and non-hospital response partners in planning, mitigating, responding to and recovering from natural and man-made disasters that impact the delivery of health care in a community or impact the environment of care for responders.
