# Construction. Renovation. Expansion.

These three words sum up much of what occurred at Jones Memorial Hospital in 2017. Departments were relocated, areas and buildings were renovated, and our affiliation with UR Medicine was expanded and strengthened during its second year.

One of the new faces on our medical staff is Cardiologist David Pelkowski, MD. Dr. Pelkowski joined Wellsville Cardiology, a UR Medicine Heart & Vascular Clinic, as the medical director of the clinic. He and Nurse Practitioners Catherine Bury and Yao Zheng, provide full-time consultation and treatment for inpatients and outpatients. All JMH cardiac imaging services are now located on the third floor, in close proximity to cardiology. Also new to the medical staff is Dr. Alexander Mandych, an otolaryngologist who sees patients at Jones Memorial Hospital in the UR Medicine ENT Clinic and does surgeries at JMH. The third floor is now home to five UR Medicine Specialty Clinics at Jones: cardiology, neurology, oncology, endocrinology telemedicine, and ENT. The third floor is also home

to one of the most exciting developments of 2017: The Wilmot Cancer Institute Infusion Center, Part of Jones Memorial Hospital.

The comfort of patients and those that accompany them for treatment was one of the primary considerations in designing the WCI Infusion Center. Each of the six infusion stations has a spacious recliner with heat and massage, an individually controlled ceiling-mounted heat panel, personalized lighting, and individual televisions. The clinic also offers warm blankets, a nourishment station with soup and beverages, wireless internet, and USB ports to connect and charge electronic devices such as computers and cell phones. The convenience of locating this center at Jones Memorial eases the burden of traveling for infusion and chemotherapy.

The JMH Orthopaedic Clinic was moved to the first floor, a more convenient location for Dr. Axtell's patients – especially those who may have limited mobility. The renovations to the area, which had been occupied by Health Information Management (HIM), were completed by our facilities staff at a tremendous savings. The resulting area is a modern clinic with three exam rooms, a casting room, nurse's station, and comfortable waiting area. HIM was moved around the corner to the main hallway.

In Bolivar, the Family Medicine practice also underwent extensive updating and now has six exam rooms, a new waiting area, and a dedicated patient consultation room. Dr. Keith Gembusia moved his practice from Belvidere, joining Physician Assistant Cortni Monroe in that office.

Six of the primary care providers in the Jones Memorial Medical Practices network achieved certification from the National Committee on Quality Assurance as Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) sites. The providers who have been certified as PCMH are Dr. Keith Gembusia and Cortni Monroe, PA, in Bolivar, Dr. Pasquale Picco and Shannon Mooney, PA, in Wellsville, and Dr. Steven Collins and David Roae, FNP, in Belvidere.

## Other items of note from 2017, include:

A new nurse call system was installed in all inpatient areas. This new system on the Med/Surg unit allows direct patient to nurse communication. When a patient uses the call bell for assistance, the call goes directly to a phone the patient's assigned nurse is carrying.

Patient safety and comfort were two of the benefits of a new orthopaedic surgical table purchased with funds donated by Charlie Joyce and Otis Eastern. The table was delivered in February and put into immediate use, as were the anesthesia machines purchased at the same time, thanks to the same gift.

The diabetes self-management education program offered by the Wellsville Lions Club Diabetes Center at Jones Memorial was awarded continued recognition by the American Diabetes Association. The Diabetes Center was originally certified by the ADA in October 2006 and the center has continued to meet the standards for recertification every five years.

In the maternity department, an upgraded infant protection system was purchased with a New York State Rural Healthcare Access Development Program. In addition, the F.T. & Anna C. Manley Memorial Trust donated funds to purchase a portable infant resuscitation system.

## Staff Appointments & Recognition

Medical Imaging Director Carrie Walker accepted the position of Executive Director of Human Resources. She continues to oversee Medical Imaging. Jennifer Frungillo, who is now clinical supervisor, oversees the day to day operation of the department.

Clinical Care Manager Erik Stein accepted the position of ICU Director, which includes cardiopulmonary services.

Jason Soles joined the IT team as the Director of Information Technology. Jason comes to us through a partnership with our affiliate, St. James Mercy Hospital, where he continues to serve in the same role.

Teri Monroe accepted the position of Executive Assistant in Administration. She continues her role as the Medical Staff Coordinator.

Health Information Management/Quality Management Assistant Deanna Hackett accepted the position of HIM Lead.

Cara Galletta, PT, DPT was certified in the McKenzie Method of Mechanical Diagnosis and Therapy.

JMH Physical Therapist Christy Hart has achieved competency in vestibular rehabilitation.

JMH Patient Access Lead Christina Collins graduated from Leadership Allegany, a ten-month program sponsored by Houghton College and the Greater Allegany County Chamber of Commerce. The program provides leadership training for adult professionals living in Allegany County.

JMH Dietitian Erika Zerkowski was awarded the Sodexo Cornerstone Award for Innovation for her work on the JMH Glycemic Control Committee (GCC). The GCC developed and instituted standardized treatment protocols for diabetic inpatients. These protocols have led to better control of inpatient blood sugars without increasing hypoglycemia. Team members Erika Zerkowski, Dr. William Coch, and Lauren Morris presented the program nationally during the US Department of Health and Human Services Partnership for Patients webinar. The team demonstrated the "gold standards" of these protocols with positive trending results in a short five month period.

Michelle Monahan, who works in Rehab and in Food and Nutrition, was named the Care Champion of the Year for her kindness to a Swing Bed patient who needed help with her laundry. Swing Bed patients wear their own clothes and Michelle noticed this patient had no one to do her laundry, so Michele brought her clothes home with her and returned them clean and folded the next day.

Forces Day and transformed the front lawn at Jones Memorial into the 4th Annual Field of Flags. Each year, the community is invited to purchase flags in honor of a deceased veteran. The proceeds from the Field of Flags are donated to LEEK Hunting & Mountain Preserve, an outdoor recreational facility in Northern Pennsylvania for wounded and injured service members and veterans. Veterans were also the focus when JMH Staff teamed up with the Wellsville American Legion Post and Curves of Wellsville on a campaign to collect items for veterans who use the Bath VA. The items collected by the three organizations were delivered to Bath by Jaime White and Dennis White.

Jones Memorial was proud to sponsor two major outdoor wellness events for our community. The premier night time trail run in the region, the GLOW 5K Run & Walk had over 400 participants last year. Every spring for the past five years, walkers and runners from all over the area have converged on Island Park in Wellsville for this fun, family-oriented event.

The 25th RidgeWalk & Run required something special to celebrate this milestone. Since the beginning, the event has given participants and volunteers a commemorative t-shirt each year.

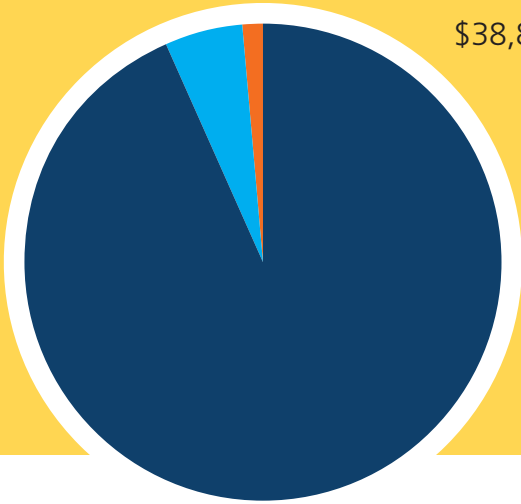
