Three-ring black leatherette notebook (23 cm.): "Transmissible Diseases" (compiled ca. 1916). Handwritten and typescript notes on a variety of communicable diseases and related topics arranged alphabetically.

Three-ring black leatherette notebook (23 cm.): "Field sanitation" (compiled ca. 1916). Alphabetically arranged handwritten and typescript notes with charts and tables from printed sources on such topics as "battlefield, hygiene of," diet, "garbage crematories," lice, "sanitary orders," etc.

Three-ring black leatherette notebook (18 cm.) describing the preparation and administration of salvarsan, Wasserman reaction test, preparation of heart-cholesterin antigen, and various standard laboratory procedures (ca. 1916).
