## About

<b>Locations</b>	Offered at OPWDD Article 16 Clinic sites in <b>Rochester, Geneseo, and Newark.</b>
<b>Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To address questions of possible dementia</li><li>• To obtain a baseline if there are concerns of dementia developing</li><li>• To assess a person's progress with dementia as needed</li></ul>
<b>Outcomes</b>	<p>A person receiving an evaluation will <b>either receive a diagnosis of a condition related to dementia or be cleared of dementia</b> at that moment. They will also receive a list of recommendations that may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Follow up with various medical providers to address possible unidentified conditions that may be contributing to the problems the person is facing</li><li>• General guidelines to help address the person's needs</li><li>• And to connect with other providers to specifically address the person's needs related to dementia</li></ul>
<b>Team Members</b>	A <b>multi-disciplinary group of professionals</b> , including a medical doctor, licensed psychologist, occupational therapist, and speech-language pathologist. <b>Caregivers and family members</b> are also a crucial part of the team!
<b>Eligibility</b>	This clinic is provided through OPWDD Article 16 services and is open to <b>anyone who qualifies for services through OPWDD.</b>
