ENGLISH PROFICIENCY ASSESSMENT FORM

FOR PROSPECTIVE J-1 EXCHANGE VISITORS

In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 62.10(a)(2), an attestation of English language proficiency is required if the University of Rochester will sponsor an individual in the J-1 non-immigrant visa status. This form must be completed by the host department confirming the J-1 exchange visitor possesses a sufficient level of proficiency in the English language and attesting to the means used to make this determination as identified below. Once signed and dated, the form and supplemental documentation must be submitted to the International Services Office (ISO) with the J-1 sponsorship application. Regulations require the ISO to retain this assessment form and all supporting evidence so it may be made available to the U.S. State Department upon request.

Host departments will be responsible for the cost of formal English language training for exchange visitors who arrive with inadequate English language skills. Cost of training: approx. \$30/hour for a minimum of 24 hours (12 weeks) or more as needed.
