- R- Research rotations (12 months required) - includes 4 hours of clinical outpatient experience per week (averaged over 4 weeks). These experiences are individualized depending on fellow's interests and personal growth plans as well as required family planning experience (opt out):
 - o FP- Family planning including in/outpatient experience in complex contraception and abortion services (opt out)
 - o PC- Adult congenital heart disease clinics/Pediatric (fetal) cardiology unit
 - o US- MFM ultrasound
 - o Consult- MFM consultation service
 - o Gen- NICU genetics (led by MFM/Genetics faculty)
 - o BF- Breastfeeding medicine (led by the breastfeeding medicine faculty)
- ICU: Intensive Care Unit in the MICU (1 month required). No required call during this rotation but fellows may opt in to call.
- LD: Labor and Delivery supervisor (2 months required- 4 rotations of 2 weeks)
- GEN: Genetics course & genetics experiences including time with reproductive genetics, pediatric genetics, and NICU genetics coverage (2 months required)
- E- Elective: This time may be used for any combination of MFM or other clinical services, and/or research in any proportion need to fit with the fellows learning plan. Elective opportunities include: MFM ultrasound, clinics or consultation services, Family planning & complex contraception, Research, Pathology, NICU, Critical care, Anesthesia, Adult congenital heart disease, genetics (pediatrics, NICU or reproductive), neuromuscular, pediatric cardiology, adult women's cardiology, breastfeeding medicine. Other options can be arranged individually, and fellows can also create their own electives.
