LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Review current ACOG and AAP/NRP guidelines for delayed cord clamping and umbilical cord milking for term and preterm infants.
- Outline best practices for setting up simulations and debriefings to improve learning outcomes.
- Describe strategies for debriefing difficult learners or situations.
- Demonstrate the effective use of video to deepen learner acquisition of knowledge and skills during team debriefings.
- Explore different situations when Hi/Lo Fidelity mannequins and techniques can be used based on learning objectives.
- Identify strategies to implement the 2016 NRP recommendations in participants' home facilities.

Morning Workshops

All attendees will participate in one of the following workshops based on their years of experience as an NRP instructor:

M1: The Nuts and Bolts of Simulation and Debriefing: Setting the Stage for Success

Participants will develop and facilitate simulations and debriefings using current best practices.

M2: Strategies for the Difficult Team Debrief

Simulation-based learning evokes different learner reactions and emotions that may surface during a team debriefing. Participants will develop strategies to facilitate different types of challenging learners and situations.

Afternoon Workshops

A1: Caught on Tape! Video-enhanced Debriefing

The use of video during debriefings promotes the acquisition and retention of knowledge and skills. Participants will learn and apply facilitation techniques using video to debrief.

A2: Rags to Riches: Low versus High Fidelity Simulation

Participants will learn how and when to use Hi/Lo fidelity simulation to create a realistic simulation environment. NRP instructors will discuss and demonstrate the use of these techniques to enhance NRP simulation.

A3: The Times They Are a Changing: Implementing the 7th Edition NRP Updates

A system-related change in clinical practice recommended by the 7th edition NRP guidelines will be presented as an example for discussion. Workshop participants will develop strategies and a model for implementation at their home facility.
