## PGY-1 Community-based Residency Program Completion of Program Requirements

- 1. NYS Licensure Per Resident Licensure Policy
- 2. Required goals and objectives
  - a. At minimum, 80% of all objectives must be achieved for the residency per the current ASHP PGY1 Residency Accreditation Standards.
  - b. The remaining 20% that are not achieved for the residency, must all at the very least, be in satisfactory progress, with no needs improvement.
- 3. Successful completion of all required and scheduled learning experiences
  - a. All assignments and activities of the learning experience as required by the primary preceptor of the rotation must be completed
- 4. Professional development log within development plan
  - a. All required activities must be completed
- 5. Guideline/Topic Discussions (minimum 8)
- 6. Research Project
  - a. Data analysis must be completed and findings presented at a professional pharmacy conference
  - b. A manuscript in a form suitable for publication must be completed prior to the last day of the residency program
- 7. Quality Improvement Project
- 8. Newsletter (audience: prescribers)
- 9. Teaching Certificate
- 10. Presentations minimum 6
  - a. 1 CE accredited presentation
  - b. 1 case presentation
  - c. 1 resident platform
  - d. Others will be assigned by rotation preceptors
- 11. Immunizations
  - a. 3 types (ex. Influenza, pneumonia, shingles, COVID)
  - b. Report in Redcap, see link in Pharmacy Practice learning description
- 12. Journal Club #6
- 13. Create or update a Collaborative Practice Agreement (CPA) or Standing Order
- 14. Community service
- 15. Business Plan or Process Improvement Plan
- 16. Medication event reporting/improvement of medication use system
  - a. All assigned events must be closed
- 17. Committee involvement/ Workgroup involvement
- 18. Pharmacademic
  - a. All assigned evaluations must be completed prior to the last day of the residency
