PGY2 Emergency Medicine Residency Program Completion of Minimum Program Requirements

- 1. NYS Licensure per Resident Licensure Policy
- 2. Required goals and objectives
 - a. 100% of R1 patient care objectives must be achieved for the residency
 - b. 100% of the following objectives must be achieved for the residency: R2.1.1, R2.1.2, R2.2.1, R2.2.2, R2.2.3, R2.2.4, R2.2.6, R5.1.1, R5.1.2
 - c. 80% of the remaining objectives in R2-R4, R6 must be achieved for the residency
 - i. The remaining 20% that are not achieved for the residency must all at the very least be in satisfactory progress, with no needs improvement
- 3. Successful completion of all required and scheduled learning experiences
 - a. All assignments and activities of the learning experience as required by the primary preceptor of the rotation must be completed
- 4. Topic discussion log See separate document
 - a. All required topics involving direct and indirect patient care must be covered
- 5. Professional development log See separate document
 - a. All required activities including certifications, competencies, presentations and journal clubs, and simulations must be completed
- 6. Patient case log See separate document
 - a. Minimum required number of patient cases met per topic
- 7. Research project
 - a. Data analysis must be completed and findings presented at UB day and EM research day
 - b. A manuscript in a form suitable for publication must be completed prior to the last day of the residency program
- 8. PharmAcademic
 - a. All assigned evaluations must be completed prior to the last day of residency
 - b. Any evaluations requiring resident co-signature must be completed prior to the last day of residency
