

PGY2 Oncology Residency Program
Completion of Minimum Program Requirements

1. NYS Licensure - per Resident Licensure Policy
2. Required goals and objectives
 - a. 100% of R1 patient care objectives must be achieved for the residency
 - b. 100% of the following objectives must be achieved for the residency: R2.1.1, R2.1.2, R2.1.3, R2.2.6
 - c. 80% of the remaining objectives in R2-R5 must be achieved for the residency
 - i. The remaining 20% that are not achieved for the residency must all at the very least be in satisfactory progress, with no needs improvement
3. Successful completion of all required and scheduled learning experiences
 - a. All assignments and activities of the learning experience as required by the primary preceptor of the rotation must be completed
4. Pocket Card completion
 - a. All required topics involving direct and indirect patient care must be signed off on
5. Professional development minimum requirements log
 - a. All required activities must be completed
6. Research project
 - a. Data analysis must be completed and findings presented at HOPA Annual Meeting
 - b. A manuscript in a form suitable for publication must be completed prior to the last day of the residency program
7. Quality Improvement/Drug Utilization Evaluation (DUE)/Economic Outcomes Analysis project
 - a. Data analysis must be completed and results presented internally
8. Drug shortage/Non-formulary request/Monograph/Guideline/Treatment plan
 - a. Assigned drug shortage/non-formulary request/monograph/guideline/ treatment plan must be completed and sent to appropriate preceptor and/or approving committee (see professional development log)
9. Presentations/Journal Club
 - a. All assigned presentations/journal clubs completed (see professional development log)
10. Medication event reporting/improvement of medication use system
 - a. All assigned events must be closed
11. Committee involvement
 - a. All assigned committee related activities must be completed or incomplete tasks handed off to RPD
12. PharmAcademic
 - a. All assigned evaluations must be completed prior to the last day of residency
 - b. Any evaluations requiring resident co-signature must be completed prior to the last day of residency
