PGY-2 Pediatric Residency Program Completion of Program Requirements

- 1. NYS Licensure per Resident Licensure Policy
- 2. Required goals and objectives
 - a. 100% of R1 patient care objectives must be achieved for the residency
 - b. 100% of the following objectives must be achieved for the residency: R2.1.1, R2.2.1, R2.2.2, R2.2.3, R2.2.4, R2.2.6, R5.1.1
 - i. The remaining goals in R2-R4 that are not achieved for the residency must all at the very least be in satisfactory progress, with no needs improvement
- 3. Successful completion of all required and scheduled learning experiences
 - All assignments and activities of the learning experience as required by the primary preceptor of the rotation must be completed
- 4. Topic discussion log See separate document
 - a. All required topics involving direct and indirect patient care must be covered
- 5. Professional development log See separate document
 - a. All required activities must be completed
- 6. Research project
 - a. Data analysis must be completed and findings presented at UB day and Annual PPA meeting
 - b. A manuscript in a form suitable for publication must be completed prior to the last day of the residency program
- 7. Drug class review/Monograph/Guideline/Protocol/Drug Use Evaluation
 - a. Assigned drug class review, monograph, treatment guideline, protocol, and/or drug use evaluation must be completed and sent to appropriate approving committee
- 8. Presentations/Journal Club/Drug Information
 - a. All assigned presentations/journal clubs/drug information requests completed (see professional development log)
- 9. Medication event reporting/improvement of medication use system
 - a. All assigned events must be closed
- 10. Committee involvement
 - a. All assigned committee related activities must be completed or incomplete tasks handed off to RPD
- 11. PharmAcademic
 - a. All assigned evaluations must be completed prior to the last day of residency
 - b. Any evaluations requiring resident co-signature must be completed prior to the last day of residency
- 12. Teaching Certificate Program
 - a. Teaching certificate program must be completed
- 13. Staffing requirements
 - a. Staffing requirements must be met (Saturday and Sunday staffing every third weekend after training period, one minor holiday, and one major holiday)
