WHO RELEASES FIRST EVER CLINICAL GUIDELINES FOR TOBACCO CESSATION IN ADULTS


WHO has released its first clinical guideline for helping adults quit tobacco. The guideline aims to assist over 750 million tobacco users trying to quit various tobacco products. Almost 70% of the population lacks access to effective cessation services due to challenges faced by health systems.

WHO's guidelines emphasize that combining pharmacotherapy with behavioral interventions significantly boosts the rate of quitting success. WHO recommends varenicline, Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT), bupropion, and cytisine for tobacco cessation. WHO also advises brief health worker counseling, intensive behavioral support, and digital interventions like text messaging and apps.

CDC MORBIDITY AND MORTALITY REPORT -TOBACCO CESSATION IN ADULTS

The majority of the 28.8 million U.S. adults who smoked cigarettes wanted to quit, approx. one-half tried to quit, but fewer than 10% were successful. Fewer than 40% of adults who smoked used treatment when trying to quit; one half received clinician advice or assistance to quit. Compared with adults who smoked nonmenthol cigarettes, those who smoked menthol cigarettes had similarly low quit success despite a higher quit attempt prevalence, potentially related to their lower treatment use.
