HHS FRAMEWORK TO SUPPORT AND ACCELERATE SMOKING CESSATION 2024

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is taking action to support and accelerate smoking cessation and reduce smoking- and cessation-related disparities.

Cigarette smoking remains the leading cause of preventable disease, disability, and premature death in the United States, including about 25% of all cardiovascular disease deaths and 30% of all cancer deaths.

The HHS Framework to Support and Accelerate Smoking Cessation uses a health equity lens to provide an organizing set of goals and broad strategies intended to enhance collaboration and coordination to drive further progress in increasing smoking cessation.

Is smoking cessation beneficial even at older ages?

Chronic smoking remains a major cause of premature mortality on a global scale. Despite intensified efforts to combat this scourge, a quarter of deaths among middle-aged adults in Europe and North America are attributed to it. However, over the past decades, antismoking campaigns have borne fruit, and many smokers have quit before the age of 40 years, enabling some casecontrol studies.


