EARLY SMOKING CESSATION AFTER CANCER DIAGNOSIS TIED TO BETTER SURVIVAL

Smokers who quit after a cancer diagnosis had increased survival, with the greatest benefit for those who initiated smoking cessation treatment within 6 months, a prospective cohort study showed.

Among over 4,500 patients diagnosed with cancer, survival over 15 years increased for those who quit smoking at 3 months (HR 0.75, 95% CI 0.67-0.83), 6 months (HR 0.79, 95% CI 0.71-0.88), and 9 months (HR 0.85, 95% CI 0.76-0.95) of follow-up.

The data also showed that smoking cessation, regardless of time of entry into the program, was associated with improved survival.

UK TO BAN DISPOSABLE VAPES IN EFFORT TO PROTECT YOUTH HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT

The UK government has officially introduced legislation to ban the sale of singleuse disposable vapes in England, Scotland, and Wales, effective from June 1, 2025. This decisive action is part of a broader commitment to reduce waste, protect public health, and support environmental sustainability.

The new law aims to address critical concerns related to disposable vape products, which are widely available and increasingly popular among young people.



CALIFORNIA COUNTY BANS SALES OF CIGARETTES WITH FILTERS IN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION MOVE

The Board of Supervisors of Santa Cruz County, California, decided to ban the sale of filtered cigarettes and cigars, making it the world's first jurisdiction to do so. Around the world, several jurisdictions are also considering filter bans, including in Belgium and the Netherlands The tobacco industry added filters to cigarettes in the 1950s in response to growing health concerns about smoking, but critics contend that they don't reduce the health risks.
