Despite generally lower rates of adult smoking, more than 43,000 Hispanic/Latino Americans are diagnosed with a tobacco-related cancer each year and more than 18,000 die as a result. Tobacco use among Hispanic/Latino youth is also cause for even greater concern.

TRACKING TECHNOLOGY CHANGES OF E-CIGARETTES: NEW SMART VAPE DEVICES

Smart vapes' are a new addition to the expanding array of e-cigarette devices. Marketed by e-cigarette manufacturers such as SMOK and iJOY, a key feature of smart vapes is a digital screen that provides information about the device and its usage. Although new to the US market, Bluetooth-enabled smart vapes have existed for some time. Leading brands such as JUUL and Vuse introduced these early versions to markets outside the USA in 2019 and 2020, respectively.



STUDY FINDS PEOPLE WHO VAPE ARE AS OUT OF SHAPE AS SMOKERS

Young people who vape perform as badly as smokers in exercise testing, according to a new study.

The findings add to growing evidence that longterm use of electronic cigarettes - known as vapes - is harmful, and challenges the idea that vaping is a healthier alternative to smoking. The study involved 60 people in their 20s who all had normal lung function, according to spirometry testing.
