PSYCHIATRIC MENTAL HEALTH CLINICS

Deaf Wellness

ELIGIBILITY: For ages 18 to 65 who are deaf or hard of hearing. (May be available for over age 65, depending on function and support and active status with a Primary Care Physician.)

DIAGNOSIS: Mood disorders, anxiety disorders, acute stress reactions to major precipitants, obsessive compulsive disorder, PTSD and trauma, panic disorders and patients with psychotic disorders.

EXCLUSION CRITERIA: Primary eating disorders and primary substance abuse/dependence disorders.

SERVICES OFFERED: Individual therapy, group therapy, psychiatric medication, consultation service, psychological testing (for established patients) and medication management (for patients enrolled in UR Medicine mental health services).

LENGTH OF SERVICES: Short-term, intermediate and long-term.

General Adult Ambulatory

ELIGIBILITY: For ages 18 to 65.

DIAGNOSIS: Mood disorders, anxiety disorders, acute stress reactions to major precipitants, obsessive compulsive disorder, PTSD and trauma, panic disorders, bipolar disorder II, personality disorders, co-morbid (substance abuse/dependence).

EXCLUSION CRITERIA: Developmental disorders, organic brain syndromes, significant head trauma, primary eating disorders, primary substance abuse disorders.

SERVICES OFFERED: Individual therapy, group therapy, psychiatric medication consultation service, psychological testing (for established patients) and medication management (for patients enrolled in UR Medicine mental health services).

LENGTH OF SERVICES: 3 to 24 months

ELIGIBILITY: For ages 18 to 65.

DIAGNOSIS: Mood disorders, anxiety disorders, acute stress reactions to major precipitants, obsessive compulsive disorder, PTSD and trauma, panic disorders and patients with psychotic disorders.

EXCLUSION CRITERIA: Primary eating disorders, primary substance abuse/dependence disorders and developmental disorders.

SERVICES OFFERED: Individual therapy, group therapy, psychiatric medication consultation service, psychological testing (for established patients) and medication management (for patients enrolled in MH&W services).

LENGTH OF SERVICES: Short-term, intermediate and long-term.

Older Adult Services

ELIGIBILITY: For ages 65 and older.

DIAGNOSIS: Major depression (single episode, recurrent, with or without psychotic features), generalized anxiety disorder, dementia with behavioral disturbances, acute stress reactions to major precipitants, panic disorders, bipolar disorders/cyclothymic disorders, psychotic disorders related to smi or cognitive deterioration, schizoaffective disorder, schizophrenia, co-morbid personality disorders, some psychotic features not associated with schizophrenia, complicated grief, and caregiver stress.

SERVICES OFFERED: Psychopharmacology consult services for Primary Care Physician offices, evidence-based individual psychotherapy and group psychotherapy (DBT informed, CBT anxiety management, behavioral activation, chronic pain, life review, complicated grief), supportive psychotherapy for caregivers of patients, and psychopharmacology services (including Clozaril and Long Acting Injectables).

LENGTH OF SERVICES: Months to years, episodic engagement.

ELIGIBILITY: For ages 18 and older with severe and persistent mental illness.

DIAGNOSIS: Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective D/O, Bipolar I Disorder, recurrent major depression (debilitating) and serious functional impairment with other diagnosis.

EXCLUSION CRITERIA: Patients should not have diagnoses that include a primary personality disorder, substance use disorder, organic brain syndromes or developmental disabilities.

SERVICES OFFERED: Individual and group therapy, specialty young adult programming, psychopharmacology services including long-acting injectable psychotropic medications, Clozapine, RN health monitoring visits and groups, trauma-related groups, targeted case management, psychosocial rehabilitation and peer support services.

LENGTH OF SERVICES: Months to years, episodic engagement.

ELIGIBILITY: Children and adolescents, birth to age 18.

DIAGNOSIS: Adjustment disorders, depression, mood disorders, bipolar disorders, anxiety, trauma and PTSD, ADHD, disruptive behavior disorders, autism spectrum disorders (mild) and psychotic disorders.

EXCLUSION CRITERIA: Youth not appropriate for this level of service.

SERVICES OFFERED: Diagnostic evaluations, individual treatment, family treatment, group treatment (social skills, DBT with patients and parents, A.L.L.Y. groups (LGBTQ), CBT for anxiety, CBT for depression), psychiatric/medication consultation, medication management, parent and school consultation, psychological testing and substance use services.

Healing through Education, Advocacy and Law (HEAL) Collaborative

ELIGIBILITY: For ages 18 and older.

DIAGNOSIS: None required. Anyone who is coping with current or past intimate partner violence or other trauma is welcome. Diagnosis is only required for psychotherapy-related services.

EXCLUSION CRITERIA: We do not provide services for perpetrators.

SERVICES OFFERED: Case management, trauma-informed therapy, safety planning and assistance with orders of protection.

LENGTH OF SERVICES: Up to six months.

DIAGNOSIS: Major depression (single episode or recurrent), generalized anxiety disorder, acute stress reactions to major precipitants, obsessive compulsive disorder, PTSD and trauma, panic disorders, bipolar disorder II (employed, intact socioeconomic status), co-morbid personality disorder, co-morbid substance abuse, family and relationships stressors and coping with illness and health issues.

SERVICES OFFERED: Individual, couple and family therapy (one member must have a diagnosable mental health disorder), evaluation for substance use disorders and psychiatric consultation.

LENGTH OF SERVICES: One year or less.

DIAGNOSIS: Major depression (single episode or recurrent), generalized anxiety disorder, acute stress reactions to major precipitants, obsessive compulsive disorder, PTSD and trauma, panic disorders, bipolar disorder II (employed, intact socioeconomic status), co-morbid personality disorder, co-morbid substance abuse, family and relationships stressors and coping with illness and health issues.

SERVICES OFFERED: Individual, couple and family therapy (one member must have a diagnosable mental health disorder), evaluation for substance use disorders and depression care management.

LENGTH OF SERVICES: One year or less.
