



CLINICAL FELLOWSHIP IN ADULT ACUTE CARE

UR Medicine –Strong Memorial Hospital is a leading academic healthcare institution located in Rochester, NY between Lake Ontario and the Finger Lakes region. As a Level 1 Trauma Center and Comprehensive Stroke Center, Strong Memorial Hospital offers over 800 acute care beds and continues to expand. As a teaching hospital, we prioritize interdisciplinary collaboration and patient-centered care. Our clinical fellowship provides motivated and committed beginning clinicians an excellent opportunity for professional development and clinical variety.

The adult acute care team is seeking a full-time, twelve-month clinical fellow to begin in the Summer of 2025. This fellowship is structured to provide mentoring and experience across specialty areas including but not limited to neurology, cardiology, transplant, trauma, surgical, and hospital medicine. Our goal is to equip motivated beginning clinicians with a solid foundation of experience and skills to become a well-rounded adult acute care speech-language pathologist. The clinical fellow will gain proficiency in performing Modified Barium Swallow Studies and will participate in Flexible Endoscopic Evaluation of Swallowing.

Job Description:

Full time, 40 hours

July 2025 - June 2026 some flexibility of start date is available.

8AM – 4:30PM; Monday through Friday for the first 6 months of fellowship then transition to Tuesday-Saturday for the second 6 months. Some holiday coverage is required.

Position Summary:

The Speech-Language Pathology Clinical Fellow (CF) will receive mentorship under the supervision of a Speech Language Pathologist (SLP) who holds a Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC). This position involves providing diagnostic and therapeutic services to patients across the continuum of scope including swallowing, speech, language, cognition, voice, and alternative means of communication. This position does not include pediatric or head and neck cancer care and does not offer opportunities for research involvement.

Minimum Requirements:

- Completion of M.A. or M.S. degree in an accredited speech-language pathology program
- Previous clinical experience providing direct patient care in a hospital setting and prior use of electronic medical records (EMR) is preferred.

Application Deadline: February 28, 2025, by midnight EST.

All applications should include the following **3** documents in PDF format. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. 1-page cover letter outlining your previous clinical experience and interest in the adult acute care fellowship.
2. Resume, not to exceed two pages.

3. Two letters of recommendation. One letter preferably from a medical placement supervisor.
