Solid Organ Transplant Example of Medication Costs

Below is a sample list of medications that you will be prescribed upon discharge from the hospital after your kidney transplant and the corresponding **CASH** price for a 1 month supply. Please keep in mind that this table includes only medications related directly to your kidney transplant. This table does not include other medications that you may require. For example, some patients may need medications to control their blood pressure or blood sugar.

Please keep in mind that if Medicare Part B pays for your transplant, then your immunosuppressant medications (tacrolimus, mycophenolate and prednisone) will be billed under Medicare Part B and you will be responsible for 20% of the cost. Your financial coordinator will let you know if your transplant is Medicare approved and can answer your questions.

Sulfamethoxazole/ Trimethoprim 400/80mg tab (generic) (Brand=Bactrim SS®)	80mg (1 tab) every Mon-Wed-Fri only #12	\$12.82	
Omeprazole 20mg cap (generic) (Brand=Prilosec®)	20mg (1cap) once daily. #30	\$128.05	
Oxycodone 5mg (generic)	1 tab every 6 hours as needed for pain. #30	\$19.73	
Sensipar® 30mg tab (Brand)	30mg (1 tab) daily. #30	\$1011.88
