Geneseo Patient Service Centers Moving We will be opening a new larger location in the new Medical Office Building at **48 E. South Street on October 7th**, **2024** to better serve our community. In preparation for this move our 2 Ryan Drive location will be permanently closing effective October 3rd, 2024 and on October 6th, our 50 E. South Street Location will be permanently closing.

Labeling Requirements for Specimens & Requisitions

Effective October 1st, 2024, any samples received with discrepant or missing information will be rejected and recollection will be required.

All samples received in the laboratory must have full first and last name of the patient, secondary identifier (DOB or MRN), collection date, collection time and collector's initials. Electronic documentation in UR Medicine's eRecord or interfaced systems meets this qualification, all others must record the information the specimen label. Link: <u>Labeling Requirements</u>
