

## CJD/Prion Markers: Delay in Testing for Total Tau Protein

Results for Total Tau will be delayed due to a supply chain issue at the National Prion Disease Pathology Surveillance Center diagnostic laboratory. Until resolved, Total Tau results will be reported as 'Pending' alongside results for RT-QuIC and 14-3-3 protein.

Once available, pending results will be updated and finalized. Pending results for Total Tau are currently expected to be available by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
