

eRecord Changes: Chromosome Analysis (CHRMS) FISH, CYTOGENETICS (FISHN)

Date: May 14th, 2025

Effective Date: June 14th, 2025

Tests impacted include:

Chromosome Analysis (CHRMS); FISH, CYTOGENETICS (FISHN)

Beginning June 14th, providers will see a format change to Cytogenetics test ordering in EPIC.

Tests Impacted: Chromosome Analysis and FISH testing

Providers will now be prompted to select a Cytogenetics indication and 4 hard stop required fields when ordering.

Cytogenetics Indications:

Oncology

- Selected for any cancer related specimens
- New required fields: Indications, Specimen Type, FISH Probes (if applicable), and Disease status

Constitutional

- Selected for any prenatal or inherited conditions specimens
- New required fields: Indications, Specimen Type, FISH probes (if applicable), and Consent

These changes are made in an attempt to simplify ordering for providers, allowing orders to be accurate and complete upon specimen receipt into the Cytogenetics Laboratory and will not affect testing, turn-around time or final report.
