



University of Rochester Visiting Sub Internship Scholarship Program

The University of Rochester Department of Urology is committed to expanding access to educational opportunities for medical students across the country. The Visiting Sub-Internship Scholarship Program is designed to support students who may not have access to a home urology program or who come from institutions with limited exposure to the field of urology. Eligible applicants must be in good academic standing at a U.S. LCME-accredited allopathic medical school and must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Scholarship recipients will have the opportunity to explore all that UR Medicine and the Department of Urology have to offer through this funded visiting sub-internship experience.

This scholarship awards \$2,000 in financial support to help offset the cost of a visiting sub internship.

All URMU Urology electives listed on VSAS are eligible for the program except the virtual electives. *Two week rotations will have reduced grant awards.*

Applicants must commit to the elective if the award is accepted. There is a no-drop policy.

Awards will be given starting on May 10th on a rolling basis no later than 2 weeks after your application until all awards are distributed.

- A brief 1-2 paragraph justification of why community-wide access to urological care is important to you and the field.
